<u>Teaching</u>	& Learning Updates:		
1. A	 a. Achieve 15% growth in grade-level proficiency on MCA Reading, Math, and Science. b. Ensure 80% or more of students meet or exceed expectations/goals on the NWEA assessment. 		
2. II	nstructional Support & Professional Development: a. Lesson Planning & Pacing Guides: i. Teachers are required to submit unit/lesson plans to instructional coaches weekly. ii. Instructional Coaches meet one-on-one with teachers to review lesson plans and ensure standards alignment. iii. Instructional Coaches provide support and feedback as needed. b. Daily exit tickets are used to assess lesson effectiveness. c. Peer learning: Teachers learn from one another through peer reviews. d. Best Practices: Teachers teach teachers and share effective strategies. e. Professional Learning Communities (PLC) are conducted and attended by one of the admin members. f. Professional Developments are planned as needed and led by instructional coaches.		

3. Student Intervention Plan:

Coon Rapids Campus: Two intervention teachers provide targeted math and reading support for students below proficiency (Targeted Group: Yellow & Orange).

East Bethel Campus: Middle school teachers implement interventions using the **WIN (What I Need)** model, grouping students by proficiency levels (Yellow & Orange). Classroom teachers also serve as interventionists during WIN time.

Reading Initiative: Recognition of a "Reader of the Month" during monthly assemblies.

Mobymax Awards: Recognition based on a chosen criteria such as: Most Improved in Reading, Most Improved in Math, Most Skills Completed, and more.

4. Data Tracker Progress Update:

Homeroom teachers assign Mobymax daily and the instructional coach (Dan) reviews Mobymax reports to track academic progress.

5. MAP Assessment Results:

Weekly Administrative Meetings are held to analyze data Bi-Weekly Meetings with the Board Chair focus on discussing students' academic progress

6. MCA Practice & Comprehensive School Plan

PD Sessions cover various MAP reports to help teachers identify and address student skill gaps.

MCA resources are shared with staff

A school-wide culture is fostered around MCA Practice & Testing.

An MCA Rally will be organized and conducted both in person and virtually at each campus.

7. Parent - Teacher Conferences:

Parent-Teacher Conferences were held on February 6th & 7th A follow-up outreach will be conducted for parents who were unable to attend.
